Student Academics

(PreK3 - Grade 5 Curriculums)

Our students are a mirror image of the diverse world in which we live. Our curriculum delivery reflects the need to be responsible, informed problem solvers as team players in a world in need of Christian evangelization.

Students excel as products of Accelerated Reading, Accelerated Math, Star Reading and Star Math, writing and phonics.

PE encourages activities that are developmentally appropriate, which include Presidential Fitness, Yoga for Kids, Tae-Bo Kick Boxing for Kids, Soccer, Basketball, Baseball, Cup Stackers and Jump Rope for Heart. Our Reading Lab and RTI (Response to Intervention) team address students of special needs for student successful achievement.

Technology & Library

Our students are well versed in the information age. Each classroom has a computer center, Smart Board, Elmo overhead, and interactive Neo-2's for every student.

Our library is a small window into the world of cyber books since our upgrade to Renaissance Learning National services. Our computer lab of twenty five Dells provides technology support, keyboarding and educational tutorials. Quizdom Learning Games utilize student clickers for interactive learning for grades K-5.

Spiritual Development

Students are taught in a secure, Christ-centered environment by certified teachers and with the assistance of aides. Religion classes meet daily with attendance at Mass on every Thursday.
