## School Uniforms 2011-12

---

The purpose of the school uniform is to serve the family in two ways – to assure equality in dress, and to reduce the cost of clothing during your child’s rapid stage of growth. As the term “UNIFORM” connotes, the dress must be standard. Each time a student is not compliant regarding Saint Louis Catholic Uniform requirements, the student will receive a Uniform Compliance Reminder note which must be signed/returned by the parent/legal guardian. If the Uniform compliance Reminder notes are not signed by the parent/legal guardian, the parent/legal guardian should expect a telephone call from the principal. Upon the 4th violation, and thereafter, the school will call the parent/legal guardian to pick up student and provide appropriate uniform according to the SLCS Handbook of School Policies, Section 28 prior to returning the student to school. The consequences of continued non-compliance will be addressed by the Principal on a case-by-case basis.

Parker School Uniforms will be providing all uniform articles for both boys and girls. Articles can be purchased at their store. They now have an Internet web-site established ([www.parkeruniforms.com](http://www.parkeruniforms.com)) to allow uniform purchases to be made through the computer. In addition, for your convenience, uniform sales are held at St. Louis School in the Fall and Spring.

### **Used uniforms are available at St. Louis school**

- **All clothing must be labeled with the child’s name.**
- **Uniforms will be optional for 3K students.**
- **Non-uniform days will be announced in advance.**

**The following are the prescribed basic articles of the St. Louis uniform:**

### **GIRLS**

#### **K4 – 2nd:**

1. Blue plaid Jumper
2. Short or long sleeved, white blouse with rounded collar (must be tucked into pants/shorts)
3. Navy blue pants or shorts

#### **3rd – 5th Grade:**

1. Blue plaid Skirt
2. White midy blouse with sailor collar and blue plaid ties
3. Navy blue pants or shorts

**NOTES:** Girls *must* wear shorts under jumper or skirt. Non-uniform shorts are acceptable only if the jumper or skirt is not removed during the school day (excluding P.E. class).  
Navy blue belt is required if pants or shorts have belt loops.

### **BOYS**

#### **K4 – 5th:**

1. Short or long sleeved white knit polo shirt
2. Navy blue pants or shorts

**NOTE:** Navy blue belt is required with pants or shorts. Shirts must be tucked into pants/shorts.

### **OUTERWEAR - GIRLS & BOYS**

Must have at least one of the three items listed below. Other light jackets are not acceptable.

1. Navy blue V-neck cardigan sweater (available at Parker School Uniforms)
2. Blue windbreaker with school logo (available at Shirts ‘N Stuff in Castroville)
3. Navy blue hooded/non-hooded sweatshirt with school logo (available at Shirts ‘N Stuff in Castroville)

**NOTE:** Heavier jackets/coats may be worn, as weather requires.

- Navy blue sweatpants with school logo can be worn (available at Shirts N Stuff in Castroville)
- Sweatpants may not be worn under jumper or skirts and are not to be worn on Mass days.

## **FOOTWEAR - GIRLS & BOYS**

1. Any closed shoe with a NON-MARKING rubber sole is acceptable.
2. Shoes for 3K and 4K must have velcro closing or tie-less laces

**FOOTWEAR - GIRLS** White socks or white tights

**FOOTWEAR - BOYS** White socks  
(colored socks or tights are not acceptable)

## **OPTIONAL ARTICLES (Girls & Boys):**

1. Light blue T-shirt with school logo (available at Shirts 'N Stuff in Castroville)  
NOTE: Can be worn on Fridays only and on school field trips. May not be worn with girls jumper or skirt.
2. White turtleneck shirt (must be worn under uniform shirt)

## **OPTIONAL ARTICLES (Girls only):**

1. Hair bows, ribbons, headbands, and scrunchies must be in school colors only.  
NOTE: Available through Parker School Uniforms but not required to be purchased through them.

## **MASS DAYS due to weather conditions (November through February):**

1. Girls are to wear jumpers, skirts or skorts.
2. Boys are to wear pants (sweatpants are not acceptable).

## **3K, 4K, Kinder, 1st Grade - Extra set of clothes:**

Because school can be a busy, active, and sometimes a delightfully messy experience, it is recommended that you send a change of clothes for your child to remain at school. These need not be uniform clothing.

A zip-lock bag makes an easy storage unit. As the seasons change, please keep this in mind and change the clothes accordingly. All outer clothing should be labeled with your child's name.
